

Doctor Voll received many honorable awards for his achievements, including the Gold Medal from the Pope Paul VI and the Kristoff Hufeland Medal of the Federal Republic of Germany.

Today, Doctor Voll's method of galvanopuncture diagnosis is used in the majority of countries.

Applying computer diagnostic devices according to Voll's method for more than seven years now I have succeeded in accumulating hundreds of observations supporting his theory.

#The female patient I., 50 years old, complained about constant fatigue during the day. No previous illness record. Underwent medical examination a year ago. Blood tests normal.

Diagnostic analysis revealed -- apart from the high level of emotional excitement -- low functionality of the thyroid gland. The patient was prescribed a set of natural preparations, which restored the function of her thyroid gland within a month.

#The patient R. 22 years old, chronic cough with asthmatic component for three-four months as a complication after tonsillitis and a course of antibiotics.

Computer diagnosis revealed disorders in the function of the large and small intestines. The patient was prescribed a set of natural preparations to restore the micro-flora of his intestines and in two weeks he was rid of the cough.

#The female patient A., 42 years old, no complaints.

Tests revealed weakened function of the pancreas. She was advised to take a test for blood sugar and a special hemoglobin test for diabetic patients. The test showed normal blood sugar level but a somewhat increased specific hemoglobin indicating the presence of diabetes.

#The female patient Y. 25 years old. After a feat of renal colic she was recommended to take an ultra-sound test which revealed a tumor in the right-side kidney.

The test based on the Voll method showed no oncologic mutation in the body. Several days after that computer tomography excluded the presence of any tumors.

#The patient A., 57 years old, requested to conduct tests without previously describing his complaints.

One of the finds was a considerably lower signal from the zone of the large intestines. After the test the patient told us that his father and elder brother died of the cancer of the large intestines. The patient was recommended to undergo a colonoscopy as soon as possible. The colonoscopy revealed multiple polyps in the large intestines.

#The female patient P., 45 years old, complained of frequent urination and the sensation of pressure in the area of the bladder. She suffered from cystitis in the past but the latest urine tests were normal.

The test showed a low function of the bladder and a food allergy. The patient took a test for allergic reaction to different foods. A heightened sensitivity of the bladder meridian to kefir was revealed. The patient confirmed that for the previous
